LARKHILL.	1916. 29 Dec		7th. F.A. Brigade consisting of 3-18 pounder Batteries and 1-4.5 Howitzer Battery left LARKHILL, SALISBURY PLAINS and entrained at ALESBURY Station for SOUTHAMPTON as follows:- Headquarters, 3.55 p.m., 25th. Battery 3 p.m. and 3.35 p.m. 26th. Battery 8.20 a.m. and 9.15 a.m. 27th. Battery 10.50 a.m. and 11.35 a.m. 107th. Battery 12.50 p.m. and 1.55 p.m. arrived at SOUTHAMPTON and embarked for HAVRE.	
HAVRE	30 Dec		Arrived and disembarked at HAVRE. Headquarters, 25th, 26th, and 27th Batteries proceeding to Rest Camp at SANVIC for the night. 107th. Battery remained at the Docks.	
	31 Dec		Brigade entrained at HAVRE for BAILLEUL. Journey took about 30 hours.	
STRAZELLE	1 Jan		Arrived BAILLEUL and detrained. Brigade then marched to STRAZELLE for concentration.	
	6 Jan		Re-organisation of Divisional Artillery, 2 Brigades with <sup>4-6</sup> gun batteries, 27th. Battery was divided, a section being attached to 25th. and 26th. Batteries. 36th. Battery 23rd. Brigade was transferred and became 27th. Battery. A section from 107th. Battery 9th. Brigade was transferred and attached to the 107th. Battery to complete.	
	9 Jan		Party consisting of U.O., CO., 4 B.Cs. 4 Subalterns, 56 telephonists, 46 gun detachments and 6 Batmen left STRAZELLE at 8.30 a.m. and proceeded to Headquarters, Right Group Artillery, Left Division, ARGENTIERES, and were attached to Headquarters and Batteries for instruction
